Sostenuto

Trumpet in C

Measures 1-7 of the Canon in D Major. The Trumpet in C part begins with a whole rest in measure 1, followed by a half note D4 in measure 2, and then a series of eighth notes in measures 3-7. The Organ part provides a harmonic accompaniment with chords in the right hand and a steady eighth-note bass line in the left hand. The tempo marking is *Sostenuto* and the dynamic is *mf espress.*

Tpt. (C)

Measures 8-12 of the Canon in D Major. The Trumpet in C part continues with eighth-note patterns, including a trill in measure 10. The dynamic marking is *cresc.*

Measures 8-12 of the Canon in D Major. The Organ part continues with its harmonic accompaniment, featuring a trill in the right hand in measure 10. The tempo marking is *Sostenuto*.
