Comment:	The Concerto for 2 Violins, Strings and Continuo in D Minor (BWV 1043) also known as the Double Violin Concerto or Bach Double, is perhaps one of the most famous works by J. S. Bach and considered among the best examples of the work of the late Baroque period. Bach wrote it between 1730 and 1731 when he was the cantor at Thomasschule, in Leipzig, Germany. Later in 1739, in Leipzig, he created an arrangement for two harpsichords, transposed into... (more online)

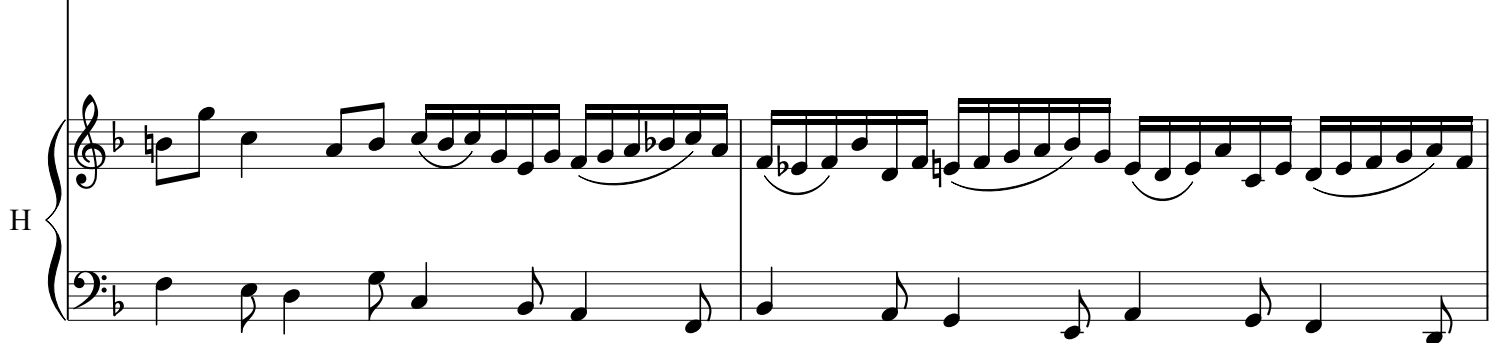
